- A medicinal plant is any plant which, in one or more of its organs, contains substances that can be used for therapeutic purposes or which are precursors for the synthesis of useful drugs. Medicinal plants have been used in healthcare since time immemorial.
- The Herbal garden has been established over an area of around 1.5 hac. in Ranikhet with funding from Japanese International Corporation Agency (JICA) scheme. The implementing agency is Research circle of Uttarakhand Forest Department.
- It has 48 high altitude medicinal plants of Himalayan region. This garden has valuable herbal species is used in various medicinal purpose.
- It showcases high altitude medicinal plants like *Aconitum heterophyllum* (Atees), *Gentiana kurroo* (Trayman), *Satyrium nepalence* (Salam mishri), *Picrorhiza kurrooa* (Kutki), *Malaxis acuminata* (Jeevak), *Polygonatum verticillatum* (Mahameda), *Rubia cordifolia* (Manjistha) etc.
